LOCAL RULE for IMMOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Please refer to the back of the Score Card, where item No4 deals with Immoveable Obstructions (Rule 24).

Points to Note:

- 1. Immoveable obstructions are just that immoveable. This includes items of course furniture such as Hoops and Ropes, (whether permanent or temporary...) sited by the Greens-staff for the protection of the course.
- 2. If an immoveable obstruction interferes with a player's stance or swing, then relief MAY be taken at the nearest point without penalty.
- 3. There is no such relief if the obstruction is merely in line with the proposed direction of play.
- 4. If a ball strikes an immoveable obstruction, irrespective of whether relief has been taken previously, then the shot MAY be replayed without penalty.
