#### Welcome and Introductions:

MK welcomed all committee members and attendees.

PK welcomed David Steel to meeting and introduced the new Vice-Captain to the committee.

### **Review of previous minutes:**

#### 2. Captains Update:

Masters Sweepstake: PK confirmed £170 was made for his charity after £75 winning monies was given out.

<u>Mens Guest Day: 20<sup>th</sup> May 2022</u> - PK is expecting approximately 60 players, all the necessary catering is in place so just hoping for sunshine and good golf. LK suggested PK speak to Buzz regarding previous year's prizes.

<u>Other Comps:</u> PK confirmed he had withdrawn from the suggestion of a Jubilee Team Comp as without full support from FPMT it would be too difficult to deliver.

New date for Simms Bowl to be played 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 – just waiting final confirmation.

<u>Catering and Clubhouse Opening Times:</u> PK asked LK if TFM had any intention of opening the clubhouse earlier at the weekends. LK said it was too difficult to get staff to come in early and wait around for the early golfers to come back in. MK asked who and what staff were now permanent members of the bar-staff. LK advised of staff that have consistent days and it was agreed by the committee and LK that it would be a good exercise for LK to produce a poster, social media post etc. picturing the staff with their names and what they do etc.

#### 3. Treasurer's Update:

PW advised all accounts are up to date and are available to be viewed on website. Financial summary attached.

PW advised CCA monies continue to have the same offenders not keeping their accounts up to date and PW has to keep chasing.

PW advised that the cheque had been sent to GOSH from PY fundraising.

#### 4. Competition Update:

PP reported weekly playing numbers were lower than normal. Singles and Pairs comps were up on the notice board but not many names! The committee discussed why this might be and what could be done to help get numbers up. It was agreed to continue as is but try and get some posters up and around the club advertising events and reminding people to look at notice boards. MK and LK to collaborate to do this utilising all key areas inside and outside the clubhouse.

DG mentioned about clubs where they have TV screens advertising events and comps etc. the committee agreed this would be nice to have - on the 'wish list' for the new owners.

It was noted 'pick and place' ends on 30<sup>th</sup> April.

Hopefully everyone is pleased with the results so far to the greens, which I'm only looking to improve.

12th and 14th tees need renovating before regular use can take place.

Tee markers still getting moved regularly.

Bunkers are regularly edged, de-weeded and raked.

SB asked when the net was due for repair as it has been a while. SB asked LK to let him know if it really was in the pipeline otherwise he would consider the repair himself. SB also asked, with tongue in cheek, if the rabbit executioner could return for the sake of the tee boxes?!

#### 8. Junior Section Update: (added to meeting agenda)

RB advised there had been a big drop in numbers – 20 down to 10 regular players. This is not completely down to juniors leaving because of Craig leaving but it is notable we don't have players coming up from Craig's Saturday morning club anymore. RB said the quality of the juniors is extremely high and reported some good wins already with good prospects for other inter club comps.
