7. Men's 2024 Programme

Easter Cup – there was a discussion on when this will take place and it was agreed that it will be brought forward a week to the Easter Weekend. The Winter League Knockout will now take place the following weekend. Kevin will announce this on Sunday at the club. It will mean that there is a three week gap instead of the usual two i.e. 31st March will be the Easter Cup and 7th April will be the Winter League Knockouts (then it reverts back to the two week cycle).

The Guest Day is yet to be confirmed, this will be held on a Friday in June as usual.
