## **SAFETY:**POOR VISIBILITY, FOG etc.

The Committee has considered suggestions about procedure when first driving from the  $1^{st}$  and  $10^{th}$  tees in conditions of poor visibility.

It is recommended that, if the nearest fairway bunker on each of the 1<sup>st</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> holes cannot be seen from its tee, then it is not safe to commence play.

If it has been possible to liaise with the group immediately in front, who have agreed to call an "**All Clear On The...** [1<sup>st</sup>/10<sup>th</sup>]", then play may continue once a clear signal has been received, and so on.

However, a ball played in any direction other than straight down the line, or when the line is not known, **must** be accompanied by the usual warning of "**FORE**" – there may be players potentially at risk at several points across the 1<sup>st</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> holes. This, of course, applies on each and subsequent holes.

In all cases, it is the player's personal responsibility to play only when safe to do so, having reasonable regard for the conditions prevailing at the time. Please be aware also, that if you are in an unexpected, unseen or potentially dangerous position on the course, you have a responsibility to ensure your own safety.

A further precaution would be to leave at least one bag or trolley within view of the following group until all your group is ready to move out of range.

**SAFETY: Please ASSESS, do not ASSUME!**
