

## LOCAL RULES

### 1. PRIORITY ON THE COURSE

- 1.1 Club Competitions have precedence over all other matches.
- 1.2 Single players should make every effort to join a group if the course is busy.
- 1.3 All players must start at the appropriate tee as directed by the Pro Shop.

### 2. OUT OF BOUNDS

*Note: "over" includes a ball being in a ditch, but above the ground level of the "in bounds" side of the ditch.*

- 2.1 Over all boundary ditches, hedges and streams (No attempt must be made to retrieve balls outside the confines of the course).
- 2.2 In the stream to the right of the 1st hole.
- 2.3 When playing the 3rd hole - on or beyond the line of the white posts to the right of the fairway.
- 2.4 When playing the 4th hole - over the RH ditch marked as a lateral water hazard.
- 2.5 When playing the 7th hole - on or beyond the line of the white markers to the right of the fairway.
- 2.6 When playing the 8th hole - on or beyond the line of white markers to the left of the fairway and beyond line of white posts behind the green.
- 2.7 When playing the 12th hole - (a) on or beyond the line of the white markers within the hedge to the right of the fairway, (b) on or beyond the 8th fairway.
- 2.8 When playing the 6th, 15th, 17th and 18th holes - on or beyond the line of white marker posts at the rear of the greens.

### 3. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

- 3.1 All ponds are water hazards (marked with yellow stakes).
- 3.2 The ditches to the sides of the 1st, 3rd, 7th, 12th, 14th, 17th and 18th holes (marked with yellow stakes).
- 3.3 Ditches to the right of the 4th and 5th fairways and between the pond, are lateral water hazards (marked with red stakes).

### 4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24)

- (a) The concrete area between the 11th tee and green.
- (b) All valve control boxes and sprinkler heads. All sewage pipe access covers.
- (c) All notice boards, marker posts and barriers whether temporary or permanent, within the confines of the course.
- (d) Wooden huts.

### 5. STAKED/WAPPED TREES (Rule 24-2)

If a player's stance or swing is impeded by such a tree, the ball **must** be lifted and dropped, without penalty, within one club-length of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole, in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b.

### 6. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25)

- 6.1 All areas marked G.U.R. or ringed in white paint or enclosed by temporary fencing.
- 6.2 Tractor tyre marks.
- 6.3 All constructed paths.
- 6.4 All tees and greens not in play.

### 7. Other Rules

Balls in depressions of drainage lines may be lifted and dropped within one club-length, not nearer the hole.
