## WINTER LEAGUE MATCH-PLAY HANDICAP CALCULATIONS UNDER WHS RULES

In four ball, better-ball match-play competitions, each player's Playing Handicap is calculated by taking $90 \%$ of their Course Handicap.

Strokes are then taken by calculating the difference between each player's Playing Handicap and the Playing Handicap of the lowest player in the group. The lowest player receives no strokes.

## Example: (Forrester Park, white tees)

| Player | H'cap INDEX | COURSE H'cap | PLAYING H'cap (90\%) | Strokes Recv'd |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| A | 8.4 | 10 | 9 | 0 |
| B | 12.9 | 15 | 14 | 5 |
| C | 16.0 | 19 | 17 | 8 |
| D | 18.4 | 21 | 19 | 10 |
